The North Allegheny High School Baseball Staff and Players present three 4-day baseball camps. Week 1 (June 21-24) will be for ages 6 to 10 at the Vincentian Baseball Complex. Week 2 (June 28-July 1) will be for ages 11 to 14 at the Vincentian Baseball Complex and Week 3 (July 5-July 8) will be for ages 6-14 at Blueberry Hill Park. Fridays of each week will be designated make up days in the event of rain.

Instruction to all groups will emphasize general throwing, hitting, baserunning and fielding mechanics.

Older groups will also be introduced to the North Allegheny High School Baseball system. Team concepts, strategy, and terminology will be taught and practiced.

Older groups will be taken through a simulated tryout. Players will be evaluated and issued a report card identifying strengths and areas in need of improvement.

All players will be involved in controlled scrimmages and games during each afternoon session.
